In follow-up to our telephone conversation of this afternoon, I am desirous of obtaining a copy of the video tape shot by Investigator Lee Blais at the direction of United States Trustee John Cullen on or about August 15, 1990, at my client's apartment in Woonsocket.

This film was taken at the time the U. S. Trustee entered my client's premises and seized documents and material. This material constitutes a large portion of the evidence you now intend to introduce at the time of trial. My client informs me that representations were made by the U.S. Trustee that he was acting under direction of the Justice Department pursuant to a criminal investigation.

I wish to view this video to either confirm or deny these allegations. Additionally, this tape constitutes statements made by my client which I contend are discoverable. In the event that you do not have a copy of this tape in your custody or control I would appreciate your advising me of same so I may subpoena a copy from the U.S. Trustee.
