Please be advised that I represent Harold Chorney, president and chief executive officer of the Cumberland Investment Corporation. I have been advised by Mr. Chorney that on August 23, 1990, at your direction, a search and seizure of evidence was conducted on the premises of the Cumberland Investment Corporation. During the course of this search certain items and documents were seized, including certain personal property belonging to Mr. Chorney. I am certain that you are aware of the Constitutional prohibitions against unreasonable searches and seizures and the protections which are afforded to citizens under the Fourth and Fourteenth Amendments to the Constitution of the United States. I am requesting, therefore, that you forward to me a complete inventory describing all items and documents which were seized from the premises of the Cumberland Investment Corporation, and further that you furnish me with copies of any documents or materials upon which you rely for the authority to enter the premises of the Cumberland Investment Corporation.
